An abbreviated four alpha character. Example: ACCT for Accounting

One of the ten major divisions within the university that offers specialized curricula.

Classes are offered either on the Fayetteville campus or are considered OFF campus.

Class status indicates if the class is: Open, Waitlisted, or Closed.

Type of class: drill, lab, lecture, etc.

Meeting times include morning, afternoon or evening.

Undergraduate level studies involving two or more academic disciplines or fields of study

Select the checkbox to include classes with a service-learning component.

The previous, current and future terms are available.

Division of faculty or instruction within a college such as Department of Accounting within the Sam M. Walton College of Business.

Level of study: Undergraduate, Graduate and Law.

Enter a specific last or first and last name. **Do not** enter instructor initials.

Unit of measure of college work. One semester credit hour is normally equivalent to one hour of class work.

Indicates if the class is held face to face, online, distance or a combination

The period for which the class meets. Regular (16 week), 10-week, 8-week, intersession, mini session, etc.

Graduate level studies involving two or more academic disciplines or fields of study.
